Internship Programme at OKDISCD, 2025

Internship programme at OKDISCD is open for young scholars from diverse Social Science disciplines. The aim of the programme is to provide opportunity to scholars to improve their research and analytical skills and get an out- of- classroom exposure to the nuances of doing Social Science and policy research.

Who can apply

- Students enrolled in full time degree programmes (Bachelor, Master, M. Phil, PhD) depending on their course requirements.
- Candidates who have completed their Masters and are looking for opportunity to enhance their research skills.

Duration of internship

The duration of the internship is for a period of not less than six (6) months.

However, students enrolled in full time degree programmes (Bachelor, Master, M. Phil, PhD), flexibility of duration, depending on the course requirements, is admissible.

Expected outcomes

Selected candidates are expected to carry out research and provide support to the ongoing study to which they will be attached with. For this, the candidate may visit the Institute's website for an idea about the broader research mandate of the Institute before applying. Candidates are also expected to submit a report at the end of the internship period, and there will be regular review of progress. It is a full time programme, therefore, regular attendance is required, besides participation in other events of the Institute. Furthermore, the internship is based at the Institute campus and no remote or hybrid mode is possible under this programme.

Note to applicants

Interested candidates may apply latest by 20th May, 2025. Only shortlisted candidates will be communicated. The selection will be sole discretion of the Institute. A fellowship of Rs 5000/- per month shall be paid only to the interns enrolling for six months internship period. However, the Institute will not be able to provide accommodation. On successful completion of the internship, candidates will be given a certificate. Applicants are requested to submit their application along with a CV and a short research proposal within 1000-1500 words, after which a round of personal interview will be held. On selection, the Institute will allot a mentor to each selected candidate based on the area of interest of the Faculty.

How to Apply

- Candidates may fill in the **Google form** given in Institute website with a detailed CV and research proposal **on or before 20th May, 2025**. The internship period will begin from **1st June, 2025**.
- Candidates applying for internship as part of their course requirement has to attach a forwarding/recommendation from the HoD/concerned authority of their respective institutions.
